IMPORTANT!**RE: AUSTRALIAN MARKET RECALL OF WORTHINGTON MANUFACTURED 14.1 OZ MAP-PRO & PROPYLENE GAS CYLINDERS**

Attn: All Bromic Customers

As a safety precaution Worthington Industries Wisconsin LLC, has initiated a recall of all Worthington manufactured 14.1oz (399.7gm) MAP-Pro, Propylene and MAPP cylinders sold into the Australian market. This includes all BROMIC branded 14.1oz (399.7gm) MAP-Pro cylinders. Any customer with a BROMIC branded MAP-Pro cylinder must review the attached recall notice issued by Worthington Industries and take relevant action as noted below:

ACTION: Customers should follow specific instruction provided in the attached recall notice. All cylinders nominated for return should be immediately quarantined from all other stock and contact with Bromic made. Bromic will immediately arrange return.

Only products branded BROMIC are to be returned to Bromic Pty Ltd.

Other Worthington manufactured brands listed in the attached recall notice are to be returned to point of purchase.

Please note; BernzOmatic & Lenox product distributed by Bromic Pty Ltd in Australia & New Zealand are not subjected to the attached recall notice

PRODUCT DESCRIPTION: Products affected include the following:

- Bromic MAP-Pro cylinder (code 1811120)
- Bromic Pro-torch kit (code 1811155)
- Bromic Tradesman's kit (code 1811170)
- Bromic complete Oxy-kit (code 1811160)
- Bromic Load-n-Lock kit (code 1811150)



NEW STOCK: Bromic has taken all possible action to ensure replacement stock is available in the Australian market as soon as possible, thus minimising the impact of this action. At present replacement stock is expected by the end of February. Continued updates will be provided as we draw nearer to the stock arrival date.

Product Safety Recall



Map-Pro, Propylene, MAPP Gas Cylinders

Manufactured in the USA by Worthington Cylinder, Wisconsin LLC

Batch numbers W month D through W month L (no I-year), number appears on baseplate of cylinder.

Sold at various plumbing and refrigeration merchants and other industrial outlets.
Distributors of the products to retail chains include Bromic, Primus and Rothenberger.

Defect Complete shut-off of the cylinder valve may be delayed for some minutes following removal of hand/brazing torch from the cylinder.

Hazard The defect will result in leakage of gas from the cylinder. Though remote, these leaks can create a potential risk of fire or explosion. There are no known incidents of fires resulting from these leaks.

What to do

- Unused cylinder (If the cylinder has never been connected to a torch or other device). Do not use cylinder. Return cylinder to store where it was purchased for exchange or a full refund.
- If the cylinder is currently connected to a torch or other device. Do not disconnect the torch or other device. Take outdoors. Ignite the torch and burn off the entire contents of the cylinder. Disconnect torch from empty cylinder. Dispose of empty cylinder per cylinder label instructions or return it to the store where it was purchased for exchange or a full refund.
- If the cylinder has been connected to a torch or other device, but is not connected now. Take cylinder outdoors. Attach torch. Ignite torch and burn off entire contents of the cylinder. Disconnect torch from empty cylinder. Dispose of empty cylinder per cylinder label instructions or return it to the store where it was purchased for exchange or a full refund.

* Never leave lit torch and cylinder unattended. Use torch only in a well-ventilated area.
